Liquid or pancake foundation – to match student's natural skin tone

Liquid or pancake foundation - several shades darker than student's natural skin tone

(for students with dark skin, choose something several shades lighter)

Loose powder (in student's natural skin tone)

Cake eyeliner (dark brown or black)

White creme stage makeup - optional

Black creme stage makeup - optional

Makeup sponges

Assortment of brushes: large powder, blush, eye shadow, eye liner, lip liner, thin pointed edge (slant tip)

Small plastic plate or palette for mixing colors

A few toothpicks

Loose paper towels

Small plastic container for water

Ziploc bag for used sponges/brushes

Carrying case to keep things together and organized

These makeup products and inexpensive brush kits can be found at craft stores or other large allpurpose stores. Crème makeup products can also be found online.

Students will also need:

- Unscented baby wipes in their kit or at home, or another preferred product for makeup removal. Students should expect to wear makeup out the door at the end of class.
- A protective smock
- Bobby pins, hair clips, or preferred device to keep hair off of face (Boys, too!)

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I will provide specialty makeup colors - Ben Nye professional products, portioned out individually to each student's palette, and a standup table mirror for each student. Special effects makeup may include corn starch, corn syrup, food coloring, Elmer's glue and/or gelatin.
